Thenergo PLC, registered at 1050 Brussels, Avenue Louise 505 box 2, VAT 0477.032.538, RPR Brussels, and its group of companies attach great significance to protecting the privacy of the visitors of this website and attempt to safeguard their privacy to the best of their ability through various technical and organizational measures. Collected personal details are not passed on to third parties, unless legally obligated.

The website and the information it contains are freely available to visitors and are exclusively intended for personal use and not for commercial purposes. Visiting the site implies the explicit acceptance of all conditions and declarations communicated below.

Most of the information on this site is available without having to supply personal data. However, the visitor may choose to complete an "email alert form" or create "a personal account".
